#### 1. Current MDL Activities

a. New electric points on C Pontoon. More planned for B. F Pontoon is at supply capacity so no further sockets are possible unfortunately.

b. There has been an 11% saving in the water bill since the leak that was repaired so it was a big one.

## 2. Winter Yard Package

A new package is planned for this year:

- a. Out for any period from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 23<sup>rd</sup> January at 30% discount. (NB/ must go back in by 23<sup>rd</sup> January but it gives the Christmas break to work on your boat.
- b. From 23<sup>rd</sup> January 6 week packages will operate.

#### 3. Dredging Programme

A contract is in negotiation to begin mid December (latest just after Christmas).

The hydro graphic survey is due this week so it is not clear yet where dredging will be required.

It is hoped that the improved shore package will encourage the maximum number of boats to come out.

#### 4. Dry Stack

There are plans to provide discounted VHF sets and training in their use from Power Boat Training UK for Dry Stack users.

There is now a quality office, VHF and 0845 number for dry stack users.

## 5. Poole Bridge Height Repeater

This has been costed at £7000 and Dave Wilson has is seeking approval for funding. There should be a decision in November.

There are plans for the Marina to provide a service to measure the air height of boats where required.

## 6. Shoreguard

Reported in the last meeting notes. There has been very limited feedback and it is considered unlikely that this will be progressed.

## 7. Away from Berth Draw

The draw for the member winners from the monthly draws to see who will win the £500 reduction in next year's berthing fee will take place at the Barn Dance.
