Dredging Operations Davis's Boatyard

Mariners are advised that dredging operations at Davis's Boatyard in Holes Bay will commence around the 21st November for approximately one month.

The work will be carried out by Jenkins Marine using the backhoe dredger "Doreen Dorward" or "JML 60". The spoil will be disposed of at the spoil ground off Swanage by the "Nab" and "Needles" or the "Buffalo" with the "Hurst".

Vessels will be exhibiting the required lights and/or shapes as per the COLREGS.

Mariners are advised to proceed with caution, at minimum speed, in the vicinity and to keep clear of the dredging vessels. Navigate with extreme caution when transiting the bridges and narrow approach channels being aware of any spoil barges restricted in their ability to manoeuvre.

This notice will self cancel on completion of the dredging operation.
