Dorset Police Marine Section has a responsibility for policing the Force's 89 miles of Dorset coastline out to the territorial limit of 12 miles. This is as well as Poole Harbour and the busy and popular Weymouth and Christchurch Harbours and not forgetting the smaller ports, West Bay, Lyme Regis and Swanage. There are millions of pounds worth of vessels registered in or moored at the miscellany of marinas and yacht clubs (50 in Poole alone) and anchorage areas along the coastline.
